## Key Components of a Privacy Policy

### 1. Introduction

- **Purpose:** Briefly explain the purpose of the Privacy Policy.

### 2. Information Collection

  - **California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA):** For residents of California.
  - **Other Local Laws:** Depending on jurisdictions where users are located.
